

# The Basic Human Polarity Divide

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### Lets call it the Great Human Polarity Divide.

The reason why there is such a polarity in the human race is because most humans do not understand what the human really is biologically, and what it is made up of. Let's try to be brief. The human is an animal with a very efficient, deep thinking process. That says it all and important things stem from it. All the talk and rhetoric about spiritual, mystical connections are just talk. None of that talk can be proven. Without proof it just does not exist. No matter the claims that thinking is evidence, in and of itself, we are saying that thinking is not evidence of anything accept, maybe that many people are capable of thinking the same thing. All thoughts are not good thoughts. All opinions are not good opinions. Many thoughts are just simply BAD. It is because the human is an animal that it inherits certain animalistic behaviours from the lower animal kingdoms. What are those behaviours? "Glad you asked."

If one observes the lower animal world one sees a striking commonality among the more advanced species like the mammals. If one pays attention to various animals, and their behaviours, one will realize that all the animals must have a belief system that they believe in so they know to behave in one way instead of behaving in another way. It is not all stimulus-response. Learning does take place. So, let's agree that your dog and your cat have beliefs systems that push their behaviours one way or another throughout the learning process.

Humans, likewise have belief systems. The belief that is common to all the mammals is that **magic is real**. Animals don't question magic. Humans, on the other hand, have a finely tuned thinking brain. In order to escape from that 'animal belief thinking', one has to apply the human thinking process. Therein lies a particular problem. Many humans do not want to apply any thinking process. Many other humans are not capable of in-depth thinking to sort out these difficult issues of magic. And still others do not educate themselves sufficiently to learn how to think through difficult issues. However, in spite of their incapacities people still want the same rights and the same conveniences, that the higher level thinking humans gain for themselves by utilizing science, which is really just a process of proving something is effective, or some idea has a high level of truth. Science strips out magic. This creates conflict because three other animal behaviours step in which modify human thinking behaviours, and outward humanity behaviours, toward others.

### **Time for Development**

So, what is the time difference between when mammals first appeared on the Earth, and humans first appeared? If we take 200 million years ago as a GENERAL time period when pre mammalian species roamed the Earth, we might be close. These early mammals would be the precursors of today's mammals including humans. These early mammals survived the extinction event of 65 million years ago because they were small in size. Those mammals flourished due to the absence of the dinosaurs. So, lets generally use half a million years ago as a probable date when humans

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appeared or, more accurately, human like animals appeared. The time difference is 64.5 million years for human precursors to develop. That is a lot of time for the animal brain to develop.

Humans then would have had about 200,000 to 250,000 years to develop into us today. The reason for all this is to grasp that a very long time was spent by the human brain getting to where it is today and throughout that time the animal brain dominated the human thinking brain.

### Four Cardinal Animal Behaviours

Three behaviours dominated along with the belief in magic. **Lying, stealing** and **killing**, are the predominant animal behaviours along with the belief in magic. Animals did not have a language so, did not discuss this with anyone. They still don't. "We never hear the dog say anything about it." But, humans do discuss it and we give names to things.

Today it takes a great deal of human thinking to counter those anciently driven four cardinal animal behaviours. The self-centeredness of the animal brain along with that animal thinking, can dominate the human. Breaking out of that pattern can be quite difficult and most people never break out of it for their entire lives. We thus, see this polarity between these two types of people, one dominated by animal thinking patterns and the other dominated by human humanitarian thinking patterns. It is all about the polarity of the animal against the human inside the human head, inside every single person.

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This triumvirate reflects the **Great Human Polarity Divide**. Understanding **war** means understanding the animal inside. Understanding **politics** means understanding the animal inside. Understanding **religion** means understanding the animal inside.

### CHANGE

Can the world change? Only by joining together with a firm commitment to human humanitarian thinking, and behaviour, can the world shift the polarity. The polarity is not static but rather is dynamic and shiftable. One can then argue that to make that shift, one has to **use the animal**.

Oh dear! And so, the world goes on in a back and forth fashion much like looking at the stars where one sees a bright object going back and forth then tries to understand what is happening with it. The human race is going back and forth. Is the trajectory inherently unmutable? We dare say no.

One might say that it is the human thinking part of the brain that makes us both human and different from the other animal species which do not have a high concern for other non family members of the species. This concern level for others, in comparison to the concern level for one's self and immediate family, can be looked at as a distinguishing factor that separates the lower animal species from the human species. One tends to think this stratification of the human species is genetically driven by genetic coding as some research points toward.

The argument then becomes the animal thinkers claiming that they too have a concern for others. While they may claim that in a conversation, when it comes to secret voting, they will default to a concern for themselves. This stratification is the polarity that is seen in the political arena. What this means is that the educated people have work to do to strip out their biases and discriminations against the uneducated or poorly educated. The issue of **hope** for a better life is

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structured around whatever part of the brain is dominant. Hope is an emotional response thus, the animal brain goes to the emotions for hope. The human part of the brain goes to logic and thinking for hope. On the human thinking side hope is structured with evidence. In the animal brain hope is purely a stimulus-response mechanism with no evidence necessary. Those are TWO different places in the brain, two different biological processes with outward behaviours matching them.

The thinking side of the human brain wants people to have the right to believe in magic because it is a coping skill to lessen stress. Children grow out of their belief in the magic of fairy tales. We understand that. Adults, on the other hand, are very reluctant to give up their coping skills even when these skills are immature and insecure behaviours. Money plays a very large roll, and that brings us back to the animal side where greed by magic leaders plays the dominant role.

We have come full circle in our thinking now and understand the true nature of the human race. Each person has a place to either perpetuate the animal inside or to reject the animal and become a fully thinking human. To be human, you should think human.
